

Ziegler d.o.o. in Croatia participated on CTIF General Assembly/Symposium

Zagreb, September 4, 2015 - The international association of fire and rescue services, CTIF held its General Assembly and Symposium in Zagreb from 3rd till 4th of September 2015.

CTIF (Comité technique international de prévention et d'extinction du Feu) was founded in 1900 in Paris, and its main goal is to encourage and promote co-operation among fire fighters and other experts in this area from all over the world. The association counts 36 member countries and nearly 50 associate members.

The day before the General Assembly, CTIF executive committee members, led by president Tore Eriksson, visited the Ziegler factory in Zagreb. Ziegler Zagreb employees presented the Ziegler brand showing all of its strengths and potentials through an example of their factory in Croatia. The guests participated in a guided tour of the power plant and were able to fully experience the vehicle production process.

Equipped with two Ziegler Quad Copters (Z-QC P3 and Z-QC I3), multimedia shows and other promotional materials, Ziegler's exhibition booth was especially attractive to all of the participants. As our Quad Copters were in the spotlight, many of the participants were interested in their characteristics. When the symposium ended, all participants went to visit the fire brigade of Zagreb, where our Ziegler TLF 30/50-5 and GW 3 were displayed. Furthermore, the Ziegler IT department demonstrated the Quad Copters in action.

After the visit of the fire brigade, all members, including the Ziegler representatives with the director Darijo MariniĆ, went to a formal reception hosted by the mayor of Zagreb, Milan BandiĆ. Mr. BandiĆ, who is also a former voluntary fire fighter, expressed his admiration for the profession and intention to support future actions in this field.

A symposium about the application of Informatics and Communication Technologies in firefighting and rescue services was held the second day of the event. Some of the topics discussed on the symposium were: Usage of GIS systems and vehicle tracking surveillance of fire fighters, application of ICT technologies in call-centers of fire/rescue services and radio-communication and surveillance. Ziegler representative, Josip AntoniĆ, held a lecture about the modern Quad Copters, as part of the final chapter about radio-communication and surveillance.
